CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to certify, That DONALD E. BOYER

of Rt. 1, Box 21, Mt. Vernon, State of OR 97865, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of a spring

a tributary of John Day River for the purpose of domestic use for one family including the irrigation of lawn and garden not to exceed one-half acre in area under Permit No. 43525 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from August 24, 1978 that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SE 1/4 NE 1/4, Section 29, T13S, R30E, WM; 770 feet North and 150 feet West from the E 1/4 Corner of Section 29.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to _____ of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

SE 1/4 NE 1/4
Section 29
Township 13 South, Range 30 East, WM

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described and is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
