a tributary of Carpenter Creek irrigation of 4.1 acres

for the purpose of

under Permit No. 36622 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from December 1, 1971

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 1.8 acre-feet stored water only

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NE 1/4 SW 1/4, as projected within Harper DLC 41, Section 12, T1S, R4W, WM; 1230 feet North and 200 feet East from SW corner, Harper DLC 41.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ------ of one cubic foot per second per acre, not to exceed 2 1/2 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described and is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
