CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That

W. E. MOONEY

of Prospect, State of OR 97536, has a right to the use of the waters of Red Blanket Creek

a tributary of Middle Fork of Rogue River for the purpose of irrigation of 102.0 acres

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Jackson County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 4, at page 1; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1889

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 2.04 cubic feet per second

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by the prior certificate recorded at page 15888, Volume 13, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT canceled by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered on May 14, 1986.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree. The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
