## CERTIFICATE OF WATER-RIGHT

under Permit No. 38086 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from March 30, 1973

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.75 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SE 1/4 SE 1/4, Section 32, T40S, R13W, WM; 1310 feet North and 950 feet West from SE Corner, Section 32.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to \_\_\_\_\_ of one cubic foot per second per acre.

This certificate is issued subject to maintenance and use of adequate treatment facilities to remove sediment before returning the water to the river.
