CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to certify, That ROY T. LANNOM

of 24660 Hwy 62, Trail, State of OR 97541, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Rogue River

a tributary of Pacific Ocean for the purpose of irrigation 0.4 acre

under Permit No. 7035 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from November 19, 1925

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.005 cubic foot per second, if available at the original point of diversion; NE 1/4 NE 1/4, Section 3, T34S, R1W, WM; 990 feet South and 285 feet West from NE corner Section 3

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NE 1/4 NE 1/4, Section 3, T34S, R1W, WM; 970 feet South and 1085 feet West from NE corner Section 3.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eighthieth of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

0.4 acre NE 1/4 NE 1/4
Section 3
Township 34 South, Range 1 West, WM

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in point of diversion approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered September 28, 1978 and together with certificate of water right recorded at page 47175, Volume 40, and certificates recorded at pages 54478, 54480, Volume 49, State Record of Water Right Certificates, supersedes certificate 9473.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described and is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
