CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to certify, That NORMAN F. and MARGO E. HOMEIER

of 10351 Highway 238, Jacksonville, State of Oregon 97530, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of a spring

a tributary of Applegate River for the purpose of domestic use for one family including the irrigation of lawn and garden not to exceed one-half acre in area under Permit No. 45726 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from April 6, 1981 that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the Lot 2 (NW 1/4 SW 1/4), Section 29, T38S, R3W, WM; 1980 feet South and 595 feet East from NE Corner, DLC 39.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to _____ of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

NE 1/4 SW 1/4
Section 29
Township 38 South, Range 3 West, WM

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described and is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
