CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That

EUGENE L. AND ETHEL A. MARS

of 2585 Queens Branch Road, Rogue River, State of OR 97537, has a right to the use of the waters of Evans Creek

a tributary of Rogue River for the purpose of irrigation of 4.5 acres

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Jackson County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 16, at page 523; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1902;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.08 cubic foot per second, if available at original point of diversion; SE 1/4 SE 1/4, Section 21, T35S, R4W, WM; 715 feet North and 540 feet West from the SE corner Section 21

The point of diversion is located in the NE 1/4 NE 1/4, Section 21, T35S, R4W, WM; 780 feet South and 180 feet West from NE corner Section 21.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

4.0 acres NE 1/4 NE 1/4
0.5 acre SE 1/4 NE 1/4
Section 21
Township 35 South, Range 4 West, WM.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in place of use and point of diversion approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered August 31, 1979 and together with certificate of water right recorded at page 48874, Volume 42, State Record of Water Right Certificates, supersedes certificate 45664.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree. The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
