CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, ThatMURPHY ELECTRIC IRRIGATION, INC.
c/o Lewis Hayes

of 8217 New Hope Road, Grants Pass, State of OR 97526, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Applegate River

a tributary of Rogue River for the purpose of irrigation of 11.2 acres

under Permit No. 16253 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from April 4, 1945

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.14 cubic foot per second, if available at the original point of diversion - SE 1/4 NW 1/4, Section 21, T37S, R5W, WM; Murphy Electric Irrigation, Inc. Ditch - 1550 feet South and 2200 feet East from the NW corner Section 21,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SE 1/4 NW 1/4, Section 21, T37S, R5W, WM; Murphy Electric Irrigation, Inc. Ditch - 1550 feet South and 2200 feet East from NW corner Section 21, SW 1/4 SW 1/4, Section 6, T38S, R4W, WM; Northside Ditch 950 feet North and 200 feet East from SW corner Section 6.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season from April 2, to October 31 of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

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Land on which water is to be used is a part of that more explicitly described by appropriator as follows:

Ruby D. Hobson: All of the Northwest one quarter of the Northeast one quarter and the Northeast one quarter of the Northwest one quarter of Section 21, Township 37 South, Range 5 West, Willamette Meridian.

Walter Sandquist: Beginning at the Southwest corner of the Northwest one quarter of the Northwest one quarter of Section 20, Township 37 South, Range 5 West, Willamette Meridian; thence running North approximately 500 feet to the County Road; thence in an easterly direction along said road approximately 600 feet; thence South to the South line of the Northwest one quarter of the Northwest one quarter of said Section: thence West to the point of beginning.

T. E. Gilmore: Beginning at the Southeast corner of the Southwest one quarter of the Southeast one quarter of Section 18, Township 37 South, Range 5 West, Willamette Meridian; run thence West 322 feet; thence North 20 rods; thence East 322 feet; thence South 20 rods to the place of beginning.

A. A. Valentine: Beginning at a point 20 rods North and 207 feet West of the Southeast corner of the Southwest one quarter of the Southeast one quarter of Section 18, Township 37 South, Range 5 West, Willamette Meridian; thence running West 207 feet; thence North 207 feet; thence East 207 feet; thence South 207 feet to the place of beginning..

This certificate is issued to confirm an additional point of diversion approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered June 17, 1981 and supersedes certificate of water right recorded at page 19726, Volume 14, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described. and is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
