CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That

R. W. HUDSON

of 4771 Fish Hatchery Road, Grants Pass, State of OR 97527, has a right to the use of the waters of Cheney Creek

a tributary of Applegate River for the purpose of irrigation of 7.0 acres

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Jackson County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 4, at page 1; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from December 15, 1893

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.12 cubic foot per second, if available at the original point of diversion; NW 1/4 NE 1/4, Sec. 18, T37S, R6W, WM; 460 feet South and 440 feet East from N 1/4 corner Section 18.

The point of diversion is located in the NE 1/4 SE 1/4, Sec. 7, T37S, R6W, WM; 1820 feet North and 750 feet West, 1450 feet North and 830 feet West both from SE corner Section 7.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

7.0 acres NE 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 7 Township 37 South, Range 6 West, WM.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in point of diversion approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered November 18, 1983, and together with certificate of water right recorded at page 51986, Volume 46, State Record of Water Right Certificates, supersedes certificate 16277.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree. The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
