CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That

M. D. AND LOUISE PATTEN

of 1229 Grays Creek Road, Grants Pass, State of OR 97526, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Greys Creek and reservoir constructed under Permit R-2070

a tributary of Applegate River for the purpose of irrigation of 2.9 acres

under Permit No. 25104 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from September 3, 1957 that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.04 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NW 1/4 SE 1/4, Section 29, T37S, R5W, WM.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year from direct flow and storage from reservoir constructed under Permit R-2070,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by the prior certificate recorded at page 29520, Volume 21, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered on August 25, 1964, approving transfer application T-63 and is issued to confirm the change in place of use approved by the same order and supersedes Certificate 29520.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described. and is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
