CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to certify, That OREGON DEPARTMENT OF FISH AND WILDLIFE

of 506 SW Mill Street, Portland, State of OR 97201, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of an intermittent stream and Crate's Point Reservoir constructed under Permit R-6891 a tributary of Columbia River for the purpose of public warm water fishing

under Permit No. 42776 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from September 29, 1977 that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.5 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SE 1/4 NW 1/4, Section 21, T2N, R13E, WM; 2058 feet South and 1870 feet East from NW corner Section 21.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to _____ of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

N 1/2 SW 1/4
Section 21
Township 2 North, Range 13 East, WM

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described and is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
