CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to certify, That HERBERT L. NORTHCRAFT

of Star Route, Box 64, Winston, State of Oregon 97496, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Olalla Creek

a tributary of Lookingglass Creek (South Umpqua River) for the purpose of stock and use in a dairy barn

under Permit No. 16603 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from September 25, 1945 that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.04 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NW 1/4 SE 1/4 as projected within J. Fisher DLC 41, Section 4, T29S, R7W, WM; 610 feet South and 190 feet East from northerly NE Corner, Fisher DLC 41.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to _____ of one cubic foot per second per acre,--

The right allowed herein is limited to the use of water only during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

NW 1/4 SE 1/4 as projected within Fisher DLC 41
Section 4
Township 29 South, Range 7 West, WM

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in use approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered March 13, 1978, and together with certificate recorded at page 46172, Volume 38, State Record of Water Right Certificates, supersedes certificate recorded at page 26096, Volume 18, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described and is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
