CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That

PHILLIP L. HOON

of Route 2, Box 120, Milton-Freewater, State of OR 97862, has a right to the use of the waters of Schwartz Spring Branch

a tributary of Pine Creek for the purpose of irrigation of 65.0 acres, domestic and stock

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Umatilla County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 7, at page 148; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1880;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 1/80 of one cubic foot per second per acre, if available at the original point of diversion in the NW 1/4 NE 1/4, Section 22, T6N, R34E, WM; Hoon-Goodman Ditch - 1040 feet South and 1090 feet East from the N1/4 corner Section 22.

The point of diversion is located in the Hoon-Goodman Ditch - No. 1 - 1040 feet South and 1090 feet East from N1/4 corner of Section 22, NW 1/4 NE 1/4,; No. 2 - 260 feet South and 1250 feet East from NW corner of Section 22, NW 1/4 NW 1/4, both in Section 22, T6N, R34E, WM

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Diversion Point No. 1

Diversion Point No. 2

5.0 acres NE 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 22 Township 6 North, Range 34 East, WM.

1.9 acres NW 1/4 SW 1/4 18.1 acres SW 1/4 SW 1/4 20.0 acres SE 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 15

20.0 acres S 1/2 NW 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 22 Township 6 North, Range 34 East, WM.

This certificate is issued to confirm changes in place of use and point of diversion approved by orders of the Water Resources Director entered June 1, 1973 and February 9, 1978, and also describes that portion of the water right confirmed by the prior certificate NOT modified by the provisions of said orders, and supersedes certificate of water right recorded at page 5520, Volume 6, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree. The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
