CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to certify, That

WALTER WHITE

of Route 2, Box 308, Milton-Freewater , State of OR 97862 , has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Dugger Creek

a tributary of Pine Creek supplemental irrigation of 39.0 acres

for the purpose of

under Permit No. 7717 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from December 28, 1926

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed

0.49 cubic foot per second, if available at the original point of diversion in the SW 1/4 SW 1/4, Section 29, T6N, R35E, WM; 300 feet North and 700 feet East from the SW corner Section 29 (Kirk Dirch #4)

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 30, T6N, R35E, WM; 810 feet South and 540 feet East from the Center $\frac{1}{4}$ corner Section 30 (Smuckal Ditch).

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

5.0 acres NE 1/4 SW 1/4
34.0 acres SE 1/4 SW 1/4
Section 30
Township 6 North, Range 35 East, WM.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in point of diversion approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered April 30, 1979, and supersedes certificate of water right recorded at page 7635, Volume 7, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described and is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
