CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to certify, That WAYNE M. TRUMBULL

of Route 3, Box 218, Milton-Freewater, State of OR 97862, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of two wells

a tributary of Goodman Spring Branch (Walla Walla River) for the purpose of supplemental irrigation of 10.0 acres

under Permit No. U-4 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from March 26, 1928

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.125 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the well. The well is located in the SW 1/4 SW 1/4, Sec. 27, T6N, R35E, WM; Well #1 - 680 feet North and 1290 feet East; Well #2 - 680 feet North and 650 feet East both from the SW corner Section 27.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eighth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

10.0 acres NE 1/4 SW 1/4 SW 1/4
Section 27
Township 6 North, Range 35 East, WM.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in point of diversion approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered April 27, 1983, and together with certificate of water right recorded at page 51608, Volume 46, State Record of Water Right Certificates, supersedes certificate 10085.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
