CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to certify, That HALL and HELEN SEELY

of 2822 W. Oriole, Roseburg, State of OR 97470, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of South Umpqua River

a tributary of Umpqua River for the purpose of irrigation of 0.9 acre

under Permit No. 6334 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from June 12, 1924

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the Lot 6 (SW 1/4 NW 1/4), Section 14, T27S, R6W, WM; 30 feet North and 1010 feet East from W 1/4 corner, Section 14.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 1/2 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

0.9 acre Lot 6 (NW 1/4 SW 1/4)
Section 14
Township 27 South, Range 6 West, WM

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in place of use approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered August 21, 1978, and, together with certificate of water right recorded at page 46385 and the order entered August 21, 1978, approving Transfer 3991, supersedes certificate of water right recorded at page 8004, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described and is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
