CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to certify, That

OREGON STATE PARKS & RECREATION DIV.
OREGON DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION

of 525 Trade St. SE, Salem, State of OR 97310, has made
proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of
Rogue River

a tributary of Pacific Ocean for the purpose of
irrigation of 10.0 acres within Valley of the Rogue State Park

under Permit No. 5695 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in
accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from
November 18, 1922
that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is
limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed
0.12 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of
diversion is located in the Lot 4 (SE 1/4 SW 1/4), Section 26, T36S, R4W,
WM; 1670 feet South and 1720 feet East from W 1/4 Corner, Section 26.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right
existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ----- of one cubic foot per second per
acre,

and shall
conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is
appurtenant, is as follows:

- 4.8 acres Lot 4 (NE 1/4 SW 1/4)
5.2 acres Lot 4 (SE 1/4 SW 1/4)
Section 26
Township 36 South, Range 4 West, WM

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in place of use and point of
diversion approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered
September 12, 1977, and modified by an order entered October 26, 1979, and
together with certificate 48962 and orders of September 15, 1976, modified
October 26, 1979, supersedes certificate 43990.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of
the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to
forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use
herein described and is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an
effective date prior to this right.
