a tributary of Umpqua River
irrigation of 5.0 acres

for the purpose of

under Permit No. 5847 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from April 20, 1923

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.062 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SE 1/4 SE 1/4 as projected within Reed DLC 58, Section 5, T25S, R5W, WM; 820 feet South and 3080 feet East from NW corner, Reed DLC 58.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

5.0 acres SW 1/4 SE 1/4 as projected within Reed DLC 58 Section 5 Township 25 South, Range 5 West, WM

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in place of use approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered March 25, 1982, and together with certificate of water right recorded at page 50896, Volume 45, State Record of Water Right Certificates, supersedes certificate 39353.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described and is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
