CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to certify, *That* CHESTER CHAMBERLIN

of Box 24, S. Myrtle Rt., Myrtle Creek, State of OR 97457, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of South Myrtle Creek

a tributary of Myrtle Creek for the purpose of irrigation of 0.6 acre

under Permit No. 7030 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from November 17, 1925

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic foot per second, if available at the original point of diversion; NE 1/4 SW 1/4, Section 27, T29S, R5W, WM; 1905 feet North and 2840 feet West from SE corner Section 27.

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NW 1/4 SE 1/4, as projected within L. Wright DLC 45, Section 27, T29S, R5W, WM; 1650 feet North and 2580 feet West from SE corner Section 27.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

0.45 acre NW 1/4 SE 1/4 as projected within L. Wright DLC 45
0.15 acre NW 1/4 SE 1/4 as projected within Joseph Cornelisons DLC 46
Section 27
Township 29 South, Range 5 West, WM

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in place of use and point of diversion approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered November 9, 1979, and supersedes certificate of water right recorded at page 7791, Volume 7, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described and is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
