CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to certify, That

ROSIE MAYES  
c/o Adele S. Harrington

of 9270 Hwy. 62, Eagle Point, State of OR 97524, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of unnamed gulch and Mayes Reservoir constructed under Application R-39681, Permit R-3965 a tributary of Antelope Creek for the purpose of irrigation of 11.2 acres

under Permit No. 29533 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from March 30, 1964 that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.05 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SW 1/4 SE 1/4, as projected within L. Tinkham DLC 50, Section 9, T36S, R1W, WM; 550 feet West and 450 feet North from SW corner, Linkswiter DLC 49.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

11.2 acres SW 1/4 SE 1/4 as projected within Tinkham DLC 50  
Section 9  
Township 36 South, Range 1 West, WM

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in use approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered January 12, 1978, and supersedes certificate of water right recorded at page 34476, Volume 26, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described and is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
