CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to certify, That JOHN MULHOLLAND

of Route 3, Box 285-B, Gaston, State of OR 97719, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of an unnamed stream and reservoir constructed under Permit R-4519

a tributary of Tualatin River for the purpose of stock and dairy barn use

under Permit No. 30155 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from December 3, 1964

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.03 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SE 1/4 SE 1/4, as projected within Hineman DLC 59, Section 31, T1S, R4W, WM; 350 feet North and 310 feet East from SW corner, Hineman DLC 59.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to -----of one cubic foot per second per acre;-----not to exceed 5.0 acre-feet during the irrigation season of each year from direct flow and storage from reservoir,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

SE 1/4 SE 1/4 as projected within Hineman DLC 59
Section 31
Township 1 South, Range 4 West, WM

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in type of use approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered October 31, 1978, and together with certificate of water right recorded at page 47121, Volume 40, State Record of Water Right Certificates, supersedes certificate 36452.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described and is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
