that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 1.11 cubic feet per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the well. The well is located in the  $$\rm NW\ 1/4\ SW\ 1/4\ Section\ 13\ Tl4S\ R44E\ WM;$  1500 feet North and 200 feet East from SW corner Section 13.

In processing the application towards issuance of the permit, it appears a clerical error was inadvertantly made in limiting the authorized quantity of water to 1.0 cfs. In the issuance of this certificate, the allowable quantity of water for use under this right has been raised to 1.11 cfs, in keeping with the customary policies and determination of this office.
