## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

**This is to certify, That** SAMUEL CUMMINGS

of Route 1, Box 127, Milton-Freewater, State of OR 97862, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of a well

a tributary of Walla Walla River (Columbia River) for the purpose of irrigation of 30.38 acres

under Permit No. G-1025 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from July 14, 1958

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.38 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the well. The well is located in the NE 1/4 SE 1/4, Section 25, T6N, R35E, WM; Well Located - 19 3/4 chains South and 12 chains West from East 1/4 corner Section 25.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

18.9 acres S 1/2 NE 1/4 SE 1/4  
Section 25

11.48 acres S 1/2 NW 1/4 SW 1/4  
Section 30

Township 6 North, Range 35 East, WM

Township 6 North, Range 36 East, WM

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by the prior certificate recorded at page 31522, Volume 23, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT changed from primary irrigation to supplemental irrigation by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered on July 7, 1986.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
