CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to certify, That OREGON DEPARTMENT OF FISH & WILDLIFE

of 506 SW Mill Street, Portland, State of OR 97201, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Wells #1 and #2

a tributary of Wallowa River for the purpose of fish rearing

under Permit No. G-8610 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from April 19, 1979 that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 250 gallons per minute; being 100 gpm from Well #1 and 150 gpm from Well #2

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the well. The well is located in the NW 1/4 SE 1/4, Section 3, T2S, R44E, WM; #1 - 80 feet South and 520 feet East; Well #2 - 10 feet South and 820 feet East both from Center 1/4 corner Section 3.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ----- of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

SW 1/4 NE 1/4
NW 1/4 SE 1/4
Section 3
Township 2 South, Range 44 East, WM

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
