CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to certify, That HAYRE'S EGG FARMS, INC.

of 12261 S. Adkins Circle, Canby, State of OR 97013, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Milk Creek

a tributary of Molalla River for the purpose of irrigation of 15.8 acres

under Permit No. 16724 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from December 15, 1945

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.20 cubic foot per second, if available at the original point of diversion, NW 1/4 NW 1/4, Section 17, T4S, R2E, W.M.

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NW 1/4 NE 1/4, Section 17, T4S, R2E, WM; 1300 feet South and 50 feet East from N 1/4 corner Section 17.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows: 5.5 acres NW 1/4 NW 1/4 10.3 acres SW 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 17 Township 4 South, Range 2 East, WM

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in point of diversion approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered January 21, 1980, and together with certificate of water right recorded at page 48997, Volume 42, State Record of Water Right Certificates, supersedes certificate 22452, Volume 16, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described and is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
