a tributary of Clackamas River irrigation of 2.1 acres and stock

under Permit No. 38855 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from November 15, 1973 for 0.03 cfs for irrigation and April 4, 1974 for 0.01 cfs* that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.04 cubic foot per second; being 0.03 cfs for irrigation and 0.01 cfs for stock

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NW 1/4 NW 1/4, as projected within James Winston DLC 69, Section 22, T2S, R2E, WM; 1950 feet South and 350 feet West from NE corner James Winston DLC 69.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

1.0 acre NE 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 21

stock & 1.1 acres NW 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 22

both as projected within James Winston DLC 69 Township 2 South, Range 2 East, WM

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described and is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
