that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.12 cubic foot per second; not to exceed 1.2 acre-feet per year

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SW 1/4 NE 1/4, as projected within Anderson DLC 50, Section 21, T9S, R3W, WM; 1950 feet South and 1820 feet West from NE corner Section 21.
