## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

## This is to certify, That

PAUL A. AND BILLIE J. MARRIOTT

of 4077 Cloverlawn Drive, Grants Pass , State of OR 97527 , has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Rogue River

a tributary of Pacific Ocean irrigation of 1.0 acre

for the purpose of

under Permit No. 12635 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from May 7, 1937

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.0125 cubic foot per second if available at the original point of diversion SE 1/4 NW 1/4, Section 15, T34S, RlW, WM

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the Lot 1, (SE 1/4 NW 1/4), Section 15, T34S, R1W, WM; 1550 feet South and 2140 feet East from NW corner Section 15

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall

 $conform\ to\ such\ reasonable\ rotation\ system\ as\ may\ be\ ordered\ by\ the\ proper\ state\ of ficer.$ 

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows: 1.0 acre Lot 1 (SE 1/4 NW 1/4)

Section 15

Township 34 South, Range 1 West, WM.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in point of diversion approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered July 1, 1985 and together with certificate of water right recorded at page 55225, Volume 50, State Record of Water Right Certificates and order approving T-5762, supersedes certificate 36496.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described and is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
