## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to Certify, That

GRANT LOW

of Dayton

, State of

Washington

has a right to the use of

the waters of Schwartz Spring Branch, a tributary of Pine Creek

for the purpose of Irrigation

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Umat111a County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 7, at page 148; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1874 for Tract #1, and 1900 for Tract #2;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed One-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre:

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurlenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

## Tract #1.

Eight (8) acres in the Northwest Quarter of the Southeast Quarter (NV-SE-1); Four and six tenths (4.6) acres in the Southwest Quarter of the Southeast Quarter (SW-SE-1), and Seven (7) acres in the Southeast Quarter of the Southeast Quarter (SE-1/2SE-1) of Section Sixteen (16). Township Six (6), North, Range Thirty-four (34) East of the Willamette Meridian, containing 19.6 acres.

## Tract #2.

Thirty-five and four tenths (35.4) acres in the Southwest Quarter of the Southeast Quarter (SW\(\frac{1}{4}\)SE\(\frac{1}{4}\)); Twenty-four and three tenths (24.3) acres in the Southeast Quarter of the Southeast Quarter (3E\(\frac{1}{4}\)SE\(\frac{1}{4}\)) of Section Sixteen (16); Forty (40) acres in the Northeast Quarter of the Northeast Quarter (NE\(\frac{1}{4}\)NE\(\frac{1}{4}\)) and forty (40) acres in the Northwest Quarter of the Northeast Quarter (NW\(\frac{1}{4}\)NE\(\frac{1}{4}\)) of Section Twenty-one (21), Township Six (6) North, Range Thirty-four East of the Willamette Meridian, containing 139.7 acres.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
