CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to certify, That WAYNE AND MARILYN NELSON

of 950 Kubli Road, Grants Pass, State of OR 97527, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Caris Creek

a tributary of Applegate River for the purpose of irrigation of 12.0 acres

under Permit No. 5395 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from

April 1, 1922 that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.15 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the Lot 2 (NE 1/4 SW 1/4), Section 30, T37S, R4W, WM; 30 feet North and 1110 feet West from NE corner I. Luellen DLC 40.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eighthieth of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

- 1.2 acres NE 1/4 SW 1/4 as projected within I. Luellen DLC 40
 - 10.6 acres NW 1/4 SW 1/4 as projected within I. Luellen DLC 40
 - 0.2 acre SW 1/4 SW 1/4 as projected within I. Luellen DLC 40
- Section 30
Township 37 South, Range 4 West, WM

This certificate is issued so as to correctly describe the place of use and together with the cancellation order entered July 29, 1986 supersedes Certificate of Water Right recorded at page 5373, Volume 6, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described and is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
