CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to certify, That ARNOLD A. AND CATHERINE PITTS

of 2819 Jumpoff Joe Creek Road, Grants Pass, State of OR 97526, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Jumpoff Joe Creek

a tributary of Rogue River for the purpose of supplemental irrigation of 3.9 acres

under Permit No. 26659 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from March 22, 1960 that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.05 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NE 1/4 SE 1/4, Section 31, T34S, R5W, WM; 670 feet South and 200 feet West from E1/4 corner Section 31.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year; provided further that the right to use of water is limited to the period when the flow of the Rogue River is more than 735 cfs at its mouth,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

2.9 acres NE 1/4 SE 1/4
1.0 acre SE 1/4 SE 1/4
Section 31
Township 34 South, Range 5 West, WM.

This certificate is issued so as to correctly describe the place of use and supersedes certificate of water right recorded at page 54503, Volume 49, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described and is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
