CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to Certify, That MRS. HANNAH E. NIETERT

of Freewater, State of Oregon has a right to the use of
 the waters of Pine Creek
 for the purpose of Irrigation

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for
 Umatilla County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order
 Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 7, at page 148; that the priority
 of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1903

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an
 amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed One acre foot per
 acre during any thirty-day period, nor three acre feet per acre during the irri-
 gation season beginning April 1st and ending October 1st.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant
 (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

Thirty-two and two tenths (32.2) acres in the Northeast Quarter of the Northwest
 Quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$); Thirty-six and four tenths (36.4) acres in the Southeast Quarter
 of the Northwest Quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$) and Three (3) acres in the Northeast Quarter of
 the Southwest Quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Twenty-seven (27), Township Six (6)
 North, Range Thirty-four (34) East of the Willamette Meridian, containing 71.6
 acres.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations
 contained in said decree.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place
 of use herein described.
