## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.015 cubic foot per second; being 0.005 cfs from each spring

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SW 1/4 SE 1/4, Section 7, SW 1/4 SW 1/4, NW 1/4 SW 1/4, Section 8, T2N, R12E, WM; #1-780 feet North and 1300 feet East; #2-520 feet North and 3160 feet East; #3-1840 feet North and 3350 feet East, all from S 1/4 corner Section 7.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to \_\_\_\_\_\_ of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:
