CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to certify, That THOMAS J. AND RUTH E. HARPOLE

of 2900 W. Oriole, Roseburg, State of OR 97470, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of South Umpqua River

a tributary of Umpqua River for the purpose of irrigation of 1.3 acres

under Permit No. 6334 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from June 12, 1924

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.02 cubic foot per second; if available at the original point of diversion; NW 1/4 SW 1/4, Section 14, T27S, R6W, WM; North 0 degrees 34 minutes West, 1788.5 feet from NW corner John Leiser DLC 53 or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the Lot 6 (SW 1/4 NW 1/4), Section 14, T27S, R6W, WM; 1890 feet North and 190 feet West from NW corner Leiser DLC 53.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

1.3 acres NW 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 14 Township 27 South, Range 6 West, WM

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in point of diversion approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered August 21, 1978, and together with certificates of water right recorded at pages 46385, 54783, Volumes 39, 50, State Record of Water Right Certificates, supersedes certificate 8004.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described and is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
