CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That

ROSEBURG LUMBER COMPANY

of PO Box 1088, Roseburg, State of OR 97470, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Cow Creek

a tributary of South Umpqua River for the purpose of industrial uses

under Permit No. 20225 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from January 9, 1951

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.1 cubic foot per second, if available at the original point of diversion; SE 1/4 NW 1/4, as projected within Israel B. Nichols DLC 44, Section 26, T30S, R6W, WM; 1850 feet South and 1590 feet East from NW corner Section 26 or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.

The point of diversion is located in the SE 1/4 NW 1/4, as projected within Catching DLC 43, Section 26, T30S, R6W, WM; 5710 feet South and 20 feet East from NW corner Flint DLC 45.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to _____ of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in point of diversion, place of use, and use approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered June 23, 1978, and supersedes certificate of water right recorded at page 24069, Volume 17, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described. and is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
