CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to certify, That VERN LIESINGER

of 520 Buell Lane, Roseburg, State of OR 97470, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of North Umpqua River

a tributary of Umpqua River for the purpose of domestic use for three families and 14 unit trailer court and 1 commercial building under Permit No. 36143 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from April 20, 1971

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.044 cubic foot per second; being 0.037 cfs for domestic use and 0.007 cfs for commercial building, if available at the original point of diversion; Lot 7 (SW 1/4 NE 1/4), Section 11, T26S, R3W, WM; South 39 degrees 30 minutes East, \* or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the Lot 7 (SW 1/4 NE 1/4), Section 11, T26S, R3W, WM; 650 feet North and 3140 feet East from W 1/4 corner Section 11.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to \_\_\_\_\_ of one cubic foot per second per acre.

\*1005 feet from the NW corner, SW 1/4 NE 1/4, Section 11.

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Lot 7 (SW 1/4 NE 1/4)
Section 11
Township 26 South, Range 3 West, WM

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in point of diversion approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered November 2, 1984, and together with certificate of water right recorded at page 52765, Volume 47, State Record of Water Right Certificates, supersedes certificate 41298.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described and is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
