and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in 2282 under Permit No. accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from

November 30, 1914

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed

0.063 cubic foot per second; if available at the original point of diversion, NW 1/4 SW 1/4, Section 15, T36S, R2W, WM; 920 feet East from W 1/4 corner Section 15

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of Lot 1 (NE 1/4 NW 1/4), Section 6, T36S, R1W, diversion is located in the WM; 1050 feet South and 490 feet West from N 1/4 corner Section 6.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per existing for the same lands, shall be limited to acre,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

5.0 acres Lot 1 (NE 1/4 NW 1/4) Section 6 Township 36 South, Range 1 West, WM

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in point of diversion approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered June 28, 1979, and together with certificate of water right recorded at page 48360, Volume 41, together with certificate of water right recorded at page 48360, State Record of Water Right Certificates, supersedes certificate 3896.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described and is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
