CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That

MARTIN S. GRIER

of 3030 Upper Applegate Rd., Jacksonville, State of OR 97530, has a right to the use of the waters of Applegate River

a tributary of Rogue River for the purpose of irrigation of 104 acres, domestic and stock use

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Jackson County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 4, at page 1; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1876

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 2.60 cubic feet per second, if available at the original point of diversion; SW 1/4 SW 1/4, Section 5, T40S, R3W, WM; Comstock Ditch - 1000 feet North and 1190 feet East from SW corner Section 5

The point of diversion is located in the SE 1/4 SW 1/4, Section 10, T39S, R3W, WM; 1030 feet North and 1150 feet West from S 1/4 corner Section 10.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

- 8.0 acres NE 1/4 NW 1/4
9.0 acres NW 1/4 NW 1/4
18.0 acres SW 1/4 NW 1/4
9.0 acres SE 1/4 NW 1/4
11.0 acres NE 1/4 SW 1/4
18.0 acres NW 1/4 SW 1/4
23.0 acres SW 1/4 SW 1/4
8.0 acres SE 1/4 SW 1/4
Section 10
Township 39 South, Range 3 West, WM

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in point of diversion approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered January 17, 1979, and together with Special Order Volume 32, page 396, supersedes certificate of water right recorded at page 16237, Volume 13, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree. The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
