CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That

MARGARET ELANOR HAYWOOD

of 937 Oak Street, Ashland, State of OR 97520, has a right to the use of the waters of Ashland Creek

a tributary of Bear Creek for the purpose of irrigation of 5 acres

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Jackson County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 4, at page 1; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1886

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic foot per second, if available at the original point of diversion; NE 1/4 SW 1/4, Section 4, T39S, R1E, WM; Rogers Ditch - 1260 feet South and 930 feet West from Center Section 4

The point of diversion is located in the SE 1/4 NW 1/4, as projected within J. Helman DLC 40, Section 4, T39S, R1E, WM; 340 feet North and 770 feet West from Center Section 4.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

5 acres SE 1/4 NW 1/4
Section 4
Township 39 South, Range 1 East, WM

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in point of diversion approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered May 26, 1978, and supersedes certificate of water right recorded at page 16012, Volume 13, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree. The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
