CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to Certify, That CLARENCE R. and MARGARET E. WILLIAMS

of Aurora, State of Oregon has a right to the use of the waters of Bachert Creek for the purpose of Domestic and Stock

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Clackamas County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the TATE ENGINEER, in Volume 6, at page 187; that the right of said right exists by virtue of ownership of land riparian to said stream;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed A reasonable amount of water for stock and domestic purposes upon their said lands, as hereinafter described:

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

Beginning at a point 7.50 chains East of the SW corner of the NW 1/4 of Section 18, T 4 S. R. 1 E. W. M., thence North 20 chains; thence E 14.57 chains; thence south 20 chains to the center line of Section 18; thence South 89 degrees 45' West 14.57 chains to the place of beginning, containing 29.14 acres, more or less, save and excepting from the above 1.53 acres theretofore deeded to Clackamas County for public road purposes, together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereto belonging and in any wise appertaining, and also all their estate, right, title and interest in and to the same including dower and claim of dower.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
