CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to certify, That

of 245 SW Central, Grants Pass , State of OR 97526 , has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Rogue River

a tributary of Pacific Ocean irrigation of 0.7 acre

for the purpose of

under Permit No. 12239 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from July 1, 1936

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed

0.01 cubic foot per second measured at the point of diversion from the River, if available at the original point of diversion; NW 1/4 NE 1/4, Section 19, T36S, R5W, WM; 810 feet South and 1800 feet West from NE corner Section 19

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NW 1/4 NE 1/4, Section 19, T36S, R5W, WM; 1030 feet South and 2070 feet West from NE corner Section 19.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

0.7 acre NW 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 19 Township 36 South, Range 5 West, WM

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in point of diversion approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered August 11, 1980, and together with certificate of water right recorded at page 49707, Volume 43, State Record of Water Right Certificates, supersedes certificate 11865

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described and is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
