CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That

PETER W. JR. AND WILLIAM B. SCHOENINGH

of RFD, Haines, State of OR 97823, has a right to the use of the waters of North Powder River

a tributary of Powder River for the purpose of irrigation of 157.0 acres and stock use

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Union County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 3, at page 252; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1893 for the irrigation of 147.6 acres and 1904 for 9.4 acres

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 3.93 cubic feet per second from March 1 to July 1 and 1.96 cfs from July 1 to October 1 of each year; the total quantity diverted during each irrigation season not to exceed 393 acre feet, if available at the original point of diversion in the SW 1/4 NW 1/4, Section 30, T7S, R38E, WM; Joe Savage Ditch - 2250 feet South* The point of diversion is located in the SE 1/4 SW 1/4, Section 19, T7S, R38E, WM; Mansfield Ditch - 1310 feet North and 2310 feet East from the SW corner Section 19.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in point of diversion approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered May 24, 1983, and together with certificate of water right recorded at page 55560, Volume 51, State Record of Water Right Certificates, supersedes certificate 1507.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree. The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
