CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to certify, That CURLEY AND BLANCH ANGELL

of Star Rt. 1, 204 Sunset Valley Rd, Burns, State of OR 97720, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of a well

a tributary of Harney Lake for the purpose of irrigation of 64.7 acres

under Permit No. G-7992 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from February 14, 1978 that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.81 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the well. The well is located in the SW 1/4 SE 1/4, Section 32, T24S, R31E, WM; 380 feet North and 1480 feet West from SE corner Section 32.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

25.6 acres SW 1/4 SE 1/4
39.1 acres SE 1/4 SE 1/4
Section 32
Township 24 South, Range 31 East, WM

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
