CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to certify, That LORENCE C. PFAFFLE

of Route 2, Box 162, Milton-Freewater, State of OR 97862, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of South Branch of Mud Creek

a tributary of Walla Walla River for the purpose of irrigation of 34.3 acres

under Permit No. 10439 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from November 16, 1931

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.42 cubic foot per second, if available at the original point of diversion in the SW 1/4 NW 1/4, Section 20, T6N, R35E, WM; 190 feet North and 230 feet East from the W 1/4 corner Section 20

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SE 1/4 NE 1/4, Section 19, T6N, R35E, WM; 1560 feet South and 630 feet West from the NE corner Section 19.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

5.8 acres NE 1/4 NE 1/4	8.5 acres NW 1/4 NE 1/4
20.0 acres SE 1/4 NE 1/4	
Section 19	
Township 6 North, Range 35 East, WM	

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in point of diversion approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered September 13, 1976, and together with certificate of water right recorded at page 43792, Volume 35, State Record of Water Right Certificates, supersedes certificate 9602.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described and is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
