CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That

MAXWELL IRRIGATION COMPANY

of Echo, State of OR, has a right to the use of the waters of Umatilla River

a tributary of Columbia River for the purpose of irrigation of 161.0 acres, domestic and stock use, also municipal and domestic supply for the City of Stanfield, Oregon

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Umatilla County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 3, at page 127; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from September 11, 1894

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 2.01 cubic feet per second, subject to the provisions of paragraph 33 of said decree and 11.5 cubic feet per second being allowed for Municipal and domestic supplies for the City of Stanfield, Oregon.

The point of diversion is located in the SE 1/4 NW 1/4, Section 8, T.3N., R.29 E., W.M., Dillon Ditch.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by the prior certificate recorded at page 2583, Volume 3, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered on April 11, 1951, approving transfer application No. 0-17, and of the Water Resources Director entered February 24, 1986, approving Transfer application No. 5699, and together with the certificates recorded at pages 55603, 55604, Volume 51, supersedes Certificate 2583.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree. The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
