## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

**This is to certify,** *That* JERRY NOBLE

of 260 Kubli Road, Grants Pass, State of OR 97526, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Applegate Slough

a tributary of Applegate River for the purpose of supplemental irrigation of 21.1 acres

under Permit No. 43268 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from May 24, 1978 that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.26 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SW 1/4 SW 1/4, Section 36, T37S, R5W, WM; 380 feet North and 1300 feet East from SW corner Section 36.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eighth of one cubic foot per second per acre, 4.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, provided further that although declared herein to be for supplemental irrigation the right allowed may, in the interest of conserving the ground water supplies, be exercised at times when water is available in the ground water supply provided that the total quantity diverted from all sources of supply does not exceed the limitation allowed herein,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

11.8 acres SW 1/4 SW 1/4  
 1.4 acres Lot 6 (SE 1/4 SW 1/4)  
 4.9 acres SE 1/4 SW 1/4 as projected within Davidson DLC 57  
 3.0 acres SW 1/4 SE 1/4 as projected within Davidson DLC 57  
 Section 36  
 Township 37 South, Range 5 West, WM

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described and is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
