CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That

JOHN F. HARMON

of 6124 New Hope Road, Grants Pass, State of OR 97526, has a right to the use of the waters of Applegate River

a tributary of Rogue River for the purpose of irrigation of 86.2 acres

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Jackson County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 16, at page 523; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1902

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 1.72 cubic feet per second, if available at the original point of diversion; NW 1/4 NE 1/4, Section 19, T37S, R5W, WM; Murphy Ditch - South 20 degrees East 780 feet from N 1/4 corner Section 19

The point of diversion is located in the SE 1/4 SE 1/4, Section 14, T37S, R6W, WM; 835 feet North and 1140 feet West from SE corner Section 14.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

39.6 acres NE 1/4 SE 1/4
12.0 acres in that part of NW 1/4 SE 1/4
Section 14
described as follows:

Beginning at the SE corner of the NW 1/4 SE 1/4, Section 14, T37S, R6W, WM; thence North parallel to section line 818 feet; thence West parallel to East and West quarter section line 977 feet to the bank of the Applegate River; thence Southeasterly along said bank to the South line of NW 1/4 SE 1/4; thence East 266 feet to the point of beginning;

34.6 acres SE 1/4 SE 1/4
Section 14
Township 37 South, Range 6 West, WM

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in point of diversion approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered April 10, 1980, and supersedes certificate of water right recorded at page 32875, Volume 24, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree. The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
