CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to certify, That DORIS G. NEEDHAM

of 4505 60th Avenue NE, Salem, State of OR 97305, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of an unnamed stream and North Reservoir constructed under Permit R-4491

a tributary of Little Pudding River for the purpose of recreation

under Permit No. 29993 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from August 25, 1964 that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.05 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NE 1/4 SW 1/4, as projected within C. Pitney DLC 72, Section 4, T7S, R2W, WM; 170 feet South and 1070 feet East from NW corner, C. Pitney DLC 72.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to _____ of one cubic foot per second per acre, The use of water shall be limited to the irrigation season of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

NE 1/4 SW 1/4
as projected within C. Pitney DLC 72
Section 4
Township 7 South, Range 2 West, WM

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in use approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered August 5, 1985, and supersedes certificate of water right recorded at page 35023, Volume 27, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described and is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
