CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to certify, That LEE H. AND MARION B. THOMPSON

of 24130 SW Grahams Ferry Rd., Sherwood, State of OR 97140, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of four wells

a tributary of Tualatin River for the purpose of irrigation of 9.2 acres

under Permit No. G-2654 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from May 6, 1964

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.12 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the well. The well is located in the SE 1/4 SE 1/4, Section 34, T2S, R1W, WM; Well 1 - 1000 feet North and 180 feet West; Well 2 - 770 feet North and 550 feet West; Well 3 - 1000 feet North and 1010 feet West; Well 4 - 1300 feet North and 1020 feet West; all from SE corner Section 34.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

9.2 acres SE 1/4 SE 1/4
Section 34
Township 2 South, Range 1 West, WM

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in point of appropriation approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered July 16, 1984, and supersedes certificate of water right recorded at page 40696, Volume 32, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
