CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That FIRST NATIONAL BANK OF PENDLETON

of Pendleton, State of Oregon, has
a right to the use of the waters of Snow and Three Creeks

a tributary of Squaw Creek for the purpose of
irrigation of 38.4 acres and storage

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for
Deschutes County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of
the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 6, at page 20; that the priority of the right
thereby confirmed dates from 1897

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an
amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 2.5 acre-feet per
acre, including the loss of seepage from the diversion point to the lands,
during each irrigation season,

The point of diversion is located in the

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as
follows:

27.6 acres NW 1/4 SW 1/4
10.8 acres SW 1/4 SW 1/4
Section 1
Township 16 South, Range 10 East, WM

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by the
prior certificate recorded at page 14788, Volume 12, State Record of Water
Right Certificates, NOT canceled by the provisions of an order of the State
Engineer entered December 10, 1974, NOR modified by the provisions of an order
of the Water Resources Director entered on May 9, 1980, approving Transfer
Application B-152.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of
the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to
forfeiture or abandonment.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein
described.
